Who is Hamas?

HAMAS is an acronym that translates from Arabic to Islamic Resistance Movement.

hamas is also a Hebrew word that means “violence”

HAMAS was formed in late 1987 at the beginning of the first Palestinian intifada (uprising). Its root are in the Palestinian branch of the Muslim Brotherhood. The control roughly two million Muslims in the Gaza Strip. Their main source of funding comes from Iran as well as business holdings in Sudan, Algeria, Turkey, the UAE and other countries.

Hamas has one purpose: the annihilation of Jews

Does the Bible say anything about the current war?

The answer: maybe

Ezekiel 38:1-9 – The word of the Lord came to me: ² “Son of man, set your face against God, of the land Magog, the prince of Rosh; prophecy against him ³ and say: ‘This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I am against you, O Gog, prince of Rosh. ⁴ I will turn you around, put hooks in your jaws and bring you out with your whole army – your horses, your horsemen fully armed, and a great horde with large and small shields, all of them brandishing their swords. ⁵ Persia (Iran), Cush (Sudan) and Put (Libya) will be with them, all with shields and helmets, ⁶ also Gomer (southern Russia) with all its troops, and Beth Togarmah (Turkey) from the far north with all its troops – and many nations with you.

⁷ “Get ready; be prepared, you and all the hordes gathered about you, and take command of them. ⁸ After many days you will be called to arms. In future years you will invade a land that has recovered from war, whose people were gathered from many nations to the mountains of Israel, which had long been desolate. They had been brought out from the nations, and now all of them live in safety. ⁹ You and all your troops and the many nations with you will go up, advancing like a cloud covering the land.”
